

This Lenten Season

"Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me" Psalms 51:10 (NRSV)

an we skip this part? Can we fast-forward through the hard and painful moments? Can we just do Easter? Are we there yet? No, No, No and No! Is this journey worth the ultimate destination? Yes, yes, yes and yes!

Please take note of the images above---ashes, palms, nails and a crown of thorns---simple yet poignant symbols of the Lenten Season as well as that of Holy Week.

What is not shown is the image of a "Resurrected Christ"---the very foundation of our Christian faith. We don't get to see that right now because we have not gone the distance.

We will travel one step at a time with our Lord throughout the final days of his life and ministry---we will hear his plea in the Garden of Gethsemane---we will bear witness to his betrayal, arrest, trial, walk to the cross, crucifixion, death, and burial. And we will do this both as a community of faith and as individual children of God.

We will be humbled and shamed by a human race that could not trust and embrace such a sacred love as we will find ourselves overcome with gratitude for the "Word of God made flesh." We are not simply to check-off the mile markers of this journey, noting with

pride how quickly we arrived at our final destination---without having to stop for gas, food, or use of a restroom. Instead, we will remember our fresh entry into this season on Ash Wednesday, February 13th and the 40 weekdays to follow. We will wave our palms on Palm Sunday as we enter into the solemnity of Holy Week. We will observe Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and The Saturday Vigil.

If we are honest and true to ourselves and our Lord, we will face with humility and boldness the spiritual turmoil, pain and anguish that await our Lord and ourselves. We will mourn and grieve and confess our sin before we have the right to rejoice.

Easter will arrive on Sunday, March 31st---the "Resurrection of the Lord." There will be new clothes, new souls, packed pews, heavenly hallelujahs, the promise of new beginnings and the reality of our salvation! Through Jesus Christ, death, and sin have been kicked to the curb!

"Lent (n.) – (in the Christian religion), an annual season of fasting and penitence in preparation for Easter, beginning on Ash Wednesday and lasting 40 weekdays to Easter, observed in the Roman Catholic, Anglican and certain other churches", from Webster's Encyclopedic Unabridged Dictionary of the English Language.

Lent is observed by Christian

faiths throughout the world, including:

- Eastern Orthodox
- Eastern Catholics
- Coptic
- Ethiopian
- Eritrian Orthodoc
- Tewahedo Church
- Anglicans
- Protestant Denominations
- and others.

Liturgical colors:

Purple or blue - during Lent Black - during Good Friday White - Easter Resurrection of the Lord

Some Symbols: ashes, palms, nails, crown of thorns, cross, fish, loaves of bread, cup of salvation, lilies...a stone rolled away **T imeline**: 40 weekdays, not counting Sundays

When Lent begins: Ash Wednesday

Traditional preparations: prayer, penance, repentance, almsgiving, and self-denial

It is the traditional belief that Jesus lay for 40 hours in the tomb.

Seek to learn more about: Fat Tuesday, Ash Wednesday, Spy Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, The Saturday Vigil (Holy Saturday), Easter Sunday, and the Season of Easter.
