Dear Gregory Memorial, Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words; their voice is not heard; yet their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. ~Psalm 19:1-4a

Some of you have started to hear bits & pieces of this, in meetings and conversations as we've discussed what is offered here at Gregory Memorial. I want all of you to know, though, some of what I see and have in mind as we begin moving forward together. And so, here is my "Three Point Plan," so to speak...

- 1. I want to encourage an atmosphere of storytelling. I am a fan of Doctor Who, and every time this nearly immortal Doctor interacts with humans, they ask, "What's so special about me, a mere human, compared to you?" It's a question that echoes Psalm 8. The answer, always, is that each and every human is unique and special, with a story that no other human can tell. I want us, as members of this congregation and of Christ's church, to learn to tell our stories, the ways in which we have encountered the Divine Love of God. I want to share my story with you; I want to hear your story, in return. So -Consider this your official invitation to invite me to sit down over dinner, over lunch, over coffee, and share your story! I want to hear it, and will be in touch about getting together...
- 2. I want to help each and every one of us journey deeper in committed discipleship. I'm working under a bit of assumption here, but I'm assuming that each of you has had some form of encounter with the Divine; without that, there isn't much to keep you coming to church. I want to help you expand on that encounter, and grow deeper. The greatest invitation each disciple received was,

"Come, and See." It is still the invitation to each of us. My role here is to be a resource in your journey as a disciple, a 'travel guide' so to speak, not telling you what your journey should look like, but simply how best to avoid pitfalls and hiccups.

3. *I want to foster in each of us a greater ability and conviction to go out into the world*, starting with Prince George County. I recall the words of the Lord to David in 2 Samuel 7, when the Lord insists that he has never desired a temple, but has always dwelt among the people, out in the fields and forests, wherever they might be. Such is our call, not to come to worship only and proclaim to one another the good news we have received – if that's all we ever do, then we're preaching to the proverbial choir! No, our call is to go out to the people of God wherever they may be, whoever they may be, and share with them the good news of salvation, inviting them to claim it, as well.

So, that is my three-fold hope, my vision for who we at Gregory Memorial are to be. My thought is that, in the months to come, we will work together to renew our mission and vision together, and then in all things we do – worship, mission, events & fellowship, education, giving, everything – each and every aspect of Gregory Memorial will be shaped for God's glory in the proclamation of the gospel. I hope you'll join me in this; I think we're in for a wonderful journey!
